### **One Night of Expected: Monitoring Well Destruction/ERH Electrodes Construction Work**

To whom it may concern:

Please be advised that off-peak hour work will be conducted at 2907 E Street, starting Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 8:00 PM, and ending on Thursday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 5:00 AM. The work will be conducted within the limits of 2907 E Street. The work will include destruction of monitoring wells and installation of ERH electrodes as outlined in West Environmental Services & Technology, Inc.'s, *Remedial Action Plan OU-1: On-Site Remediation* (“OU-1 RAP;” May 2015).

While noise levels will be measured in the residential neighborhood during night work, West Environmental Services & Technology, Inc., would appreciate feedback on noise levels observed by residents. Additionally, a local Stakeholder Working Group meeting will be held at 2907 E Street on August 18, 2015 at 3:00 PM to discuss noise levels experienced during implementation of the *OU-1 RAP*, and how that could affect the work hours for implementation of the *Draft Remedial Action Plan OU-2: E Street Remediation (OU-2 Draft RAP)*.
