Request for Public Participation, Shell-Branded Service Station #204-7525-0104, 6131 Pacific Avenue, Stockton, San Joaquin County

California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) staff reviewed the *Revised Feasibility Study, Corrective Action Plan, and Request for Site Closure* (NFA Request) dated 14 October 2015, submitted on behalf of Shell Oil Products US (Shell), by GHD Services, Inc. (GHD).

Based on my review of the NFA Request, I believe this case is a good candidate for low threat closure. Prior to a finding of no further action required, a 60-day public comment period must pass, and all remaining Site wells must be destroyed and or be transferred to the responsible parties for the Miller Trust Property groundwater investigation.

Therefore, by **15 January 2016**, please submit a draft Fact Sheet, a map Figure depicting the areal extent of groundwater impacted above drinking water standards, and a proposed distribution list. The distribution list must include the following: municipal and county water districts, water replenishment districts, special act districts with groundwater management authority, agencies with authority to issue building permits for land affected by the petroleum release, owners and occupants of the property impacted by the petroleum release, the owners and occupants of all parcels overlying and within 500 feet of the groundwater pollution, and this office.

The draft Fact Sheet must notify interested parties of the request for case closure and the current site conditions. A statement of the time to reach water quality objectives should also be included in the Fact Sheet. An example draft Fact Sheet is attached and an electronic copy will be emailed to your consultant, GHD, on 14 December 2015.

The Fact Sheet figure will need to be included with the draft Fact Sheet for our review, and must show the subject site, the estimated extent of the groundwater impacts above drinking water standards, and the properties being notified. We can work with you and your consultant, through email to provide edits of the draft Fact Sheet, figure, and distribution list.
