Hello Kaitlyn,

Our agency has reviewed the recent submittal, *Letter Technical Memorandum – Soil Vapor Extraction Fall-off Test and Closure Request* (dated January 29, 2016), prepared by AECOM. Additionally, we have reviewed other relevant historical data contained in the case file. Based on this review, our agency has determined that the referenced cleanup project appears eligible for closure. Site closures are processed in the order they were identified, with the timeframe needed for final issuance of a “No Further Action” (NFA) letter dictated by agency resources/project workload and completion of other administrative procedures, including public comment/stakeholder notification requirements. This agency will send additional correspondence to authorize well abandonment and remediation system decommissioning upon completion of the required public comment period.
