Mr. Lockwood:

BP requested closure on the above referenced site location on March 28, 2014 that was based on an updated CSM and VI investigation report of findings. We have been working closely with ACEH over the past year and appreciate the progress that has occurred on many of our sites. Throughout this time, we have had numerous meetings with ACEH LOP and have either completed our closure paths or have agreed on the path to closure. We are very satisfied with our progress.

As such and because of our relationship with ACEH to quickly respond and agree on this site's impediments to closure, BP respectfully asks that the SWRCB to wait before considering this site for closure until additional VI samples are collected and added to our SCM. If the additional VI sampling is successful (satisfies the human health risk criteria), we will again submit a closure request to ACEH for evaluation and concurrence. Barring any offsite access problems, we expect this work to be completed in the next 90 days.
