CLOSURE DENIAL REVIEW FOR PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CASE,  
KRAFT/KNUDSEN DISTRIBUTING DEPOT, 975 CALVADOS AVENUE, SACRAMENTO,  
SACRAMENTO COUNTY

State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Resolution No. 2012-0062 requires that State Water Board staff review a lead agency's decision when the lead agency has denied a request by a responsible party for an underground storage tank (UST) case closure pursuant to the Low-Threat UST Case Closure Policy (Policy).

The subject case has the following identification numbers:

- State Water Board, GeoTracker No. T0606700055
- Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board), Case No. 340078
- County of Sacramento Environmental Management Department (County), Case No. 0598

State Water Board staff reviewed the closure request dated August 2014 and the response from the County. After careful consideration of the GeoTracker record, State Water Board staff agrees with the County staff determination that all of the Policy criteria have not been met. Based on information in the above-referenced case file, this agency finds that the subject site does not meet the following Policy criteria:

- **General Criterion e.** – A conceptual site model that assesses the nature, extent, and mobility of the release has been developed.
- Groundwater Media-Specific Criteria.

An inactive domestic well (Mincey well) is located at the adjacent property to the north and within 200 feet of the site. Groundwater samples have not been collected from the Mincey well. The extent and mobility of the petroleum plume near the Mincey well cannot be determined with the existing data. A municipal well (City of Sacramento Well 112) is located approximately 300 feet east-southeast and crossgradient of the plume boundary. County staff reported that the City of Sacramento Well 112 is being prepared for operation and that full-time operation is pending. Fate and transport mechanisms that may affect the nature, extent and mobility of petroleum plume

during operation of the municipal well cannot be determined with the existing data.

Petroleum constituents in groundwater continue to pose a threat to human health, safety, and the environment. Criteria for low-threat UST case closure have not been met at this time, therefore closure of the UST case is not appropriate.
